"Wild skunks should not be picked up and handled," warns Dr. John D. Monroe, Oakland County health director. "Contrary to what you might think by reading recent stories, skunks can be extremely dangerous. Many wild animals, particularly skunks, carry rabies which is a very serious disease."

nervous system, and it is invariably fatal once symptoms appear. Rabies is usually transmitted to humans by animal bites, particularly from dogs and wild animals. Efforts to prevent rabies have been aimed at the vaccination of dogs.

It is now compulsory in Oakland County to have dogs vaccinated prior to licensing. "In view of the rabies situation, skunks and other wild animals should not be picked up for pets," advises Dr. Monroe. There is always the chance that the animal may have rabies and any bites you receive could become very serious."

Contaminated Milk on Sale At Farms, County Warns

Raw or unpasteurized milk that is grossly contaminated is being sold in Oakland County, reports Oscar Boyea of the Oakland County Department of Health.

This milk is being sold by farmers at their door directly to the public, and is never pasteurized. Anyone who drinks this milk is taking a serious health risk, Boyea added.

He said samples of this unpasteurized milk tested by the Health

Department contains an extremely high number of bacteria. The bacterial count was classified TNC or too numerous to count.

DISEASES that people may get from drinking unpasteurized milk include typhoid fever, tuberculosis, diphtheria, dysentery, gastroenteritis (including food infections and food poisoning), and communicable paratyphoid fever, scarlet fever, and septic sore throat.

Great care is taken to safeguard our milk supplies. Dairy herds are periodically inspected by state and federal departments of agriculture.

SANITARY handling procedures are also important. Proper equipment operated by personnel free of disease is essential. Even though these precautions have been taken, pasteurization is essential, says the Michigan Allied Dairy Association.

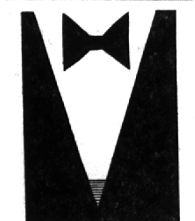
