Oakland G.O.P. Buys Black Angus Steer

Miss G. O. P. of Oakland County, Sharon Beaudoin, welcomes the champion steer purchased at the county-wide 4-H Club auction held recently in Pontiac.

The 370 pound Black Angus steer will provide the piece-de-resistance for the annual Oakland County Republican Picnic and Ox Roast on Sept. 7 at the John F. Ivory Farm. A record price of 60 cents a pound was bid by Charles Lyle, Republican county chairman.

Miss Beaudoin is a secretary at MacManus, John and Adams, Inc. of Bloomfield Hills. She resides in Franklin Village with her parents, Mr. and Mrs. Lyle C. Beaudoin.

The CHAMPION steer was raised by Jerry Langley, 15 years old of Highland. A member of the Ro-Hi Club he has been a consistent winner in 4-H livestock events.

The annual Oakland County Republican Picnic and Ox Roast is an all-day affair, starting with a pancake breakfast and ending in late afternoon with an exhibition of Roman riding.

A continuing program of entertainment is offered, as well as contests for the adults and games for the children. Roast beef sandwiches, ice cream, coffee and soft drinks are free, and there is no admission charge.

COUNTY officials and legislators will man the serving lines. Drawings are held for a variety of door prizes, and additional prizes are offered for the contests and games.

There will be free parking provided for an estimated 2,500 cars.

(Continued from 1-A) indicated in the past that he favors the proposed ordinance.

THE PLANNING commission voted, 6-2, to adopt the master plan which provides for a peripheral road that will ring the city's commercial area.

The action on the plan and the zoning ordinance came Tuesday after a long series of delays in which joint meetings of the two commissions were scheduled, postponed and rescheduled in an effort to reach a "meeting of minds" between the two bodies.

The master plan, a guide to the future growth of Bloomfield Hills, is subject to the jurisdiction of the planning commission and does not have to be approved by the city commission.

The zoning ordinance—which in effect implements the plan—can be recommended by the planners but the final decision is made by the commission.

IN OTHER action, the planning commission recommended that steps be taken to relieve congestion at the Woodward-Long Lake intersection.

As suggested by the state highway department, these three steps would improve conditions at the intersection:

- Prohibiting left-turns from Long Lake to northbound Woodward.
- Approval of a U-turn cross-over south of the intersection to handle this traffic.
- Sending a letter of intent to the highway department signifying the city's desire to acquire property for the construction of the southeast quadrant of Bloomfield Hills' proposed peripheral road.
