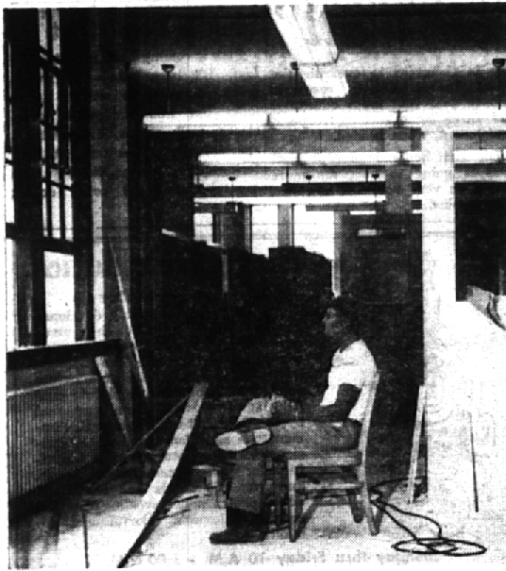


Two Receive New Posts in B'field Schools

Renovation, Cleanup Goes on at Schools

The buildings and grounds department of the Birmingham Public Schools has been busy with the renovation and cleaning of school buildings during the summer.

Reporting on the repair work were Norman Wolfe, assistant superintendent, and James V. O'Neil, supervisor in charge of buildings and grounds.

They estimated that more than 600 classrooms have been cleaned,

and 1,200,000 square feet of floors cleaned and waxed. Twenty thousand pieces of furniture were cleaned and repaired.

ALL GYM FLOORS have been cleaned and resurfaced. Boilers were inspected and repaired and thousands of windows washed.

Two hundred twenty-five acres of land have been maintained. Other projects included extensive roof repair and sidewalk re-
