

Two Real Estate Courses Slated In Redford Twp.

"Real Estate Taxation," on Tuesday evenings from 7 to 10 p.m., beginning Sept. 17, will be supervised by Julian P. Curtis, C.P.A., of Touche, Ross, Bailey and Smart, Detroit, and will feature a number of prominent guest lecturers.

The course is designed to give advanced practitioners a fundamental and specialized knowledge of taxation as it applies to the real estate business.

Chamber Notes

An organization is only as strong as its board of directors and their ability to perform in the interests of the people of the community.

The board of directors is responsible for mobilizing the resources of the community to achieve chamber of commerce objectives. It is the function of the board to see that the talents and energies of members are enlisted in chamber committees, and the responsibility and authority of committees are clearly defined.

Members of the board of directors are not expected to do all the thinking for the organization but to maintain close contact with members of the chamber and to be their sounding board.

THE BOARD of directors is the policy-forming branch of the chamber. It authorizes the organization's program of work, approves its budget and directs the general operation of the chamber. Each member of the board, if he is to serve the chamber effectively, must take an active interest in the organization as well as the operation of the committees.

Many occasions arise when a director of the chamber must serve as its official or unofficial spokesman. This responsibility requires the exercise of careful judgment, for a director's own view may not be to the best advantage of the organization he represents.

A CHAMBER director can make a contribution to the well-being of his chamber by bringing to the attention of the board suggestions he receives from citizens in the community. By doing this he enables his chamber to become more useful and effective in making his community a better place in which to live and work.

Although the by-laws of most chambers authorize the chamber president to appoint committees, it is a general practice for the president to consult with the board on committee appointments.

THE BOARD of Directors of the Birmingham Chamber of Commerce is made up of men and women from every phase of life, professional, manufacturing and retail. The nominating committee selects an "official ballot" but must be certain before announcing the ballot that each person has agreed to serve if elected.

The members of the chamber at large vote, usually by use of a mail ballot and only members in good standing are permitted to vote. The election of officers takes place within two weeks after the election of directors.

THERE ARE 13 members of the Board of Directors of The Birmingham Chamber of Commerce. Nine members are elected for three-year terms. Of these nine there are always six directors who have served before so that there are constantly board members with previous experience and knowledge of chamber activities.

Three directors are elected for a one-year period. These three also represent divisions of professional men, retailers and manufacturers.

The remaining four directors are appointed at-large and it is their duty to fulfill the demands of the president. The executive secretary (manager or director) of the chamber of commerce sits on the board of directors and serves as its secretary.

Backs Village Zone Decision

Wood Creek Farms has been upheld by the State Supreme Court in its refusal to rezone a parcel of land from residential to commercial.

After winning a circuit court verdict that made three of their four lots along Northwestern Hwy. commercial, George W. and Elizabeth Smith asked the higher court to also reclassify the fourth.

THE VALUE of the fourth lot would have been hiked from \$28,000 to \$125,000, according to evidence presented in Oakland County Circuit Court.

The Supreme Court decision said the difference in residential and commercial values should be considered "but they alone cannot be the determining factor."

The fourth lot should continue as residential, the court ruled, because, unlike the other three lots, it is suited for such a purpose.
