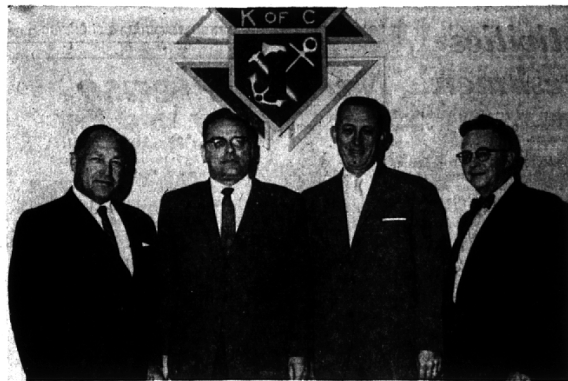

### Gas Customers Will Receive Smaller Bills

Birmingham area gas customers of Consumers Power Co. this month are receiving gas service bills from the company reflecting their share of a refund which totals \$2,400,000.

The refund recently was made to Consumers by its pipeline gas suppliers.

Customers will find an average of \$3.70 deducted from their bills if they are gas space heating customers. If they use gas for such things as cooking and water heating, but not for space heating purposes, the average deduction from current bills will be about 70 cents, the company said.

Commercial and industrial customers of the company will be refunded varying amounts according to the amounts of gas used in the three-month period March-May of this year, the period on which the amount of the refund is based.

GAS CUSTOMERS on the company's lines Aug. 27 who moved after the March-May billing period will have to apply for their refund at their nearest Consumers office before Dec. 31, 1963.

A small number of customers in other classifications, and customers who only began to use the company's gas service after Aug. 27 of this year, will receive no refund. In most cases, this will be because their monthly gas bill is smaller than the refundable amount.

Consumers says the total refund will be paid all regular customers by Oct. 2.
