

## Will-O-Way Announces Fall Class Schedule

The increasing popularity of the musical show in the theatrical world has prompted introduction of special vocal, dance and accompaniment training for Will-O-Way Apprentice Theatre students this fall.

Celia Merrill Turner, director of the dramatic trade school in Bloomfield Hills, has announced three special courses to prepare students for roles in musicals, which she says "are here to stay in American theatre."

**THE 30-HOUR** courses are offered for the first time in the fall term, opening Sept. 20 and closing Feb. 23, at the Apprentice Theatre, 775 W. Long Lake Road near Telegraph. Information about the courses will be available from Will-O-Way staff members at open houses at the theatre from 2 to 9 p.m. Sunday, Sept. 15; Saturday, Sept. 21 and Sunday, Sept. 22.

**A NEW COURSE** in vocal technique will train actors and actresses to sing effectively and to learn musical scores. Trained vocalists will learn acting techniques through the course, in which students will produce scenes from popular musicals.

**Dancing for the actor**, combined with acting for the dancer, will be included in another course on musical theatre techniques.

**A THIRD NEW** course will train organists and pianists in the special art of accompanying soloists, choruses and dancers in musicals. Enrollees will gain practical experience at accompaniment during Will-O-Way student rehearsals of scenes from musicals.

Mrs. Turner, a graduate of Juilliard School of Music, will direct the musical scenes.

Other Will-O-Way instruction includes Saturday dramatic classes for children and adult drama classes on Wednesdays and Thursdays.

Advanced Will-O-Way courses in drama and stagecraft lead to senior and master certificates and prepare students for professional stage work. Duane Pack, associate director of Will-O-Way, coaches the drama classes.

**STUDENTS MAY** elect to combine drama classes with one or all of the courses on musical theatre techniques.

### Jr. Symphony Has Year's 1st Meeting

The Southfield Junior Symphony will have its first fall meeting Saturday at 9:30 a.m. in the music room of Southfield High School. There are openings in all sections except clarinet for young people in the area who wish to become a part of the group. New auditions will be held Saturday from 1:30 to 4 p.m.

The orchestra meets every Saturday from 9:30 a.m. to noon to prepare for its two concerts later in the season. Richard Brown, instrumental music teacher in the Southfield School system, is the conductor.

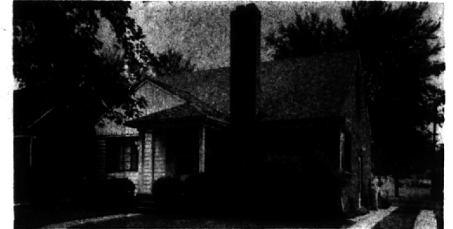
