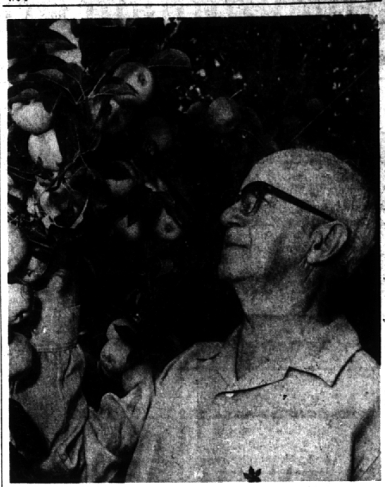

Union Pickets Bell Chapel

A union campaign to organize employees of metropolitan area funeral homes has hit Birmingham. A single picket, carrying a placard, has been appearing almost daily at the Bell Chapel of the William R. Hamilton Co. on E. Maple. The newly formed union is called the Michigan Mortuary Employees Association.

It was formed as a result of a Michigan Labor Mediation Board election at a Detroit funeral home where the employees voted to have the union represent them. The union is picketing metropolitan area funeral homes in an effort to have management recognize it. The union has asked the National Labor Relations Board to hold an election among Hamilton employees. Hamilton Co. is the largest of the area mortuaries with employees working three shifts.
