Expectant parents who want to learn about childbirth and how to care for their baby can attend the Expectant Parent Classes offered by the Oakland County Health Department.

THE SERIES consists of eight classes and covers topics which include mental health of the family unit, growth and development of the baby prior to and immediately after birth, labor and delivery, and feeding and bathing of the infant. A conducted hospital tour is arranged for all parents.

The Oakland County Medical Society, various Adult Education Departments and the Health Department jointly sponsor the classes which are taught by public health nurses.

Classes begin in Pontiac, Royal Oak and B'ham the week of Jan. 12.

**WSU Hosts Press Club Workshop**

"Cold type" printing, newspaper supplements and an address by Governor Romney's special assistant on financial affairs, constitute the program for the 19th Wayne State University Press Club Workshop. The all-day event will be held Friday, Jan. 10, in the McGregor Memorial Conference Center on the WSU campus.

L. William Seitzman, Romney aide who was the Republican candidate for State Auditor General last November, will be principal luncheon speaker. He will address the workshop on "How's Your Financial Structure?" His talk will compare various forms of newspaper ownership and will deal with taxes and accounting methods.

NEWSPAPER supplements and the best ways to produce them will be the subject of the workshop's 10 a.m. panel. Three executives of weekly newspapers will tell how their newspapers meet the problems of collecting and editing material for Christmas, Easter, Back-to-school, Fourth of July, Football season and other special editions.

Panelists will be Kenneth R. Weaver, managing editor, The Birmingham Eccentric; Harry Arnott, managing editor, Dearborn Press; and Roger Williams, editor, Marine City Independent.

Cold type printing, one of the most basic recent innovations in newspaper publication, will be examined at the afternoon session, beginning at 2 p.m. Four newspaper executives will talk about their experiences with cold type.

Dale Stafford, publisher of the Greenville Daily News, will discuss the special problems of meeting daily deadlines.

Weekly news executives will tell how they deal with their production problems. They are Walt Rummel, Sebawaing Blade; and Frank Beaumont, Wyandotte News-Herald. H. V. Henry, of the sales division of Goss Printing Co., will complete the panel.

The workshop will begin with a coffee hour and registration at 9 a.m.

ROBERT FOLEY SMITH, publisher of the Dearborn Press, is 1963-64 president of the Wayne State University Press Club. Other officers are: Duane DeLoach, Blasfield, first vice president; Ben Nathanson, Detroit, second vice president, and W. Sprague Holden, Wayne State University, secretary-treasurer.

The WSU Press Club, an informal organization of Michigan's newspapermen and women, was organized in 1958, an outgrowth of a series of informal workshops that were started by Wayne's journalism department in 1951.
