, , , Your attitudes toward yourself will affect your baby's developing self-esteem. Nor can you reasonably expect perfection in your child, or in any performance that his age level of development will not reasonably permit.

The more you can accept your efforts to do a good job as a parent without excessive striving to be perfect, the more satisfaction you will find in being a parent. If you are periodically successful in meeting attainable standards for parenthood, you will find both you and your child feeling more satisfied and able to enjoy one another.
