Michigan Conservation Dept. figures above that the state's pheasant population is well below that of a year ago.

A survey conducted by mail cartiers in late November and early December reported an average of 1.3 birds per 100 hours of driving as compared with 2.8 birds in a similar survey conducted after the 1962 hunting season.
