## **Merchant Claims Traffic Rules Causing Losses**

A complaint by a merchant that raffic regulations at the corner of Lincoln and Woodward are hurting his business was referred to the adjunistration for study by Birmingham city commissioners Monday night.

S. C. Avesian, owner of Colonial Cleaners, 1184 S. Woodward, told cammissioners that with the present set of traffic regulations it was "extremely difficult," if not impossible, to gain access" to his business from Woodward Avehica.
