Mrs. Widseth is currently on a tour of active alumni groups, and is meeting with Chicago alumni to set up an active alumni association in that city.

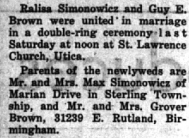
As the University of Minnesota Women's Club in this area is well-organized and active, Mrs. Widseth said this club could help considerably in setting up a successful Chicago group.

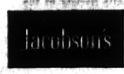
