

Vesper Service At Christ Church

Beginning Sunday, Christ Church Cranbrook will hold a vesper service at 5 p.m. This is a parish service in addition to the current Sunday schedule of 7:45, 9 and 10:45 a.m.

Patterned after the familiar English custom of Vespers or Evening Prayer, these services will provide an opportunity for those who find the morning schedule inconvenient, for students and youth groups, and for those who appreciate the end of the day as a time for worship.

THE BASIC structure of the 5 p.m. service will be Evening Prayer.

Churchwomen To Hear U-M Chaplain

The Rev. Mr. Daniel Burke, chaplain of the Episcopal Student Center at the University of Michigan, will speak to the Episcopal Churchwomen of Christ Church Cranbrook at their meeting of Tuesday, Oct. 6.

Following a celebration of the Holy Communion at 10 a.m. in St. Dunstan's Chapel, Mr. Burke will discuss the problems of academic pressures facing students of today's colleges and universities.

After luncheon he will present further insight into the matter by examining the social pressures imposed upon modern college students and the so-called "new morality".

THE REV. MR. Burke makes his home in Ann Arbor with his 8-year-old daughter. Before serving as the University of Michigan's Episcopal chaplain, Mr. Burke was the assistant minister at Ann Arbor's St. Andrew's Episcopal Church for a period of 2 1/2 years.

He received his theological training at the Episcopal seminary in Cambridge, Massachusetts, after completion of his studies at Lafayette College and Wesleyan University.

He is also currently serving as president of the Board of Directors of the Senior Citizens' Guild of Ann Arbor. An invitation is extended to all women of the area to attend. Reservations for the noon luncheon are to be made to the Church office by Friday, Oct. 2.
