Cite Need for Director Of Vocational Education

A director of vocational education for Oakland Schools was deemed "absolutely crucial" by an Oak Park school board member at a meeting of delegates from school boards throughout Oakland County.

Sixteen boards were represented at the recent meeting. Pell Holdingshead was the delegate from the Birmingham Board of Education.

A post of coordinator of Federal programs was made as an alternate suggestion by Arthur P. Parklan, Oak Park trustee.

Parklan said the Oak Park schools had hired two people to develop a vocational education curriculum in that district. A person on the intermediate school district staff, he said, would possibly be more effective in helping schools plan vocational programs that would bring Federal funds to local districts.

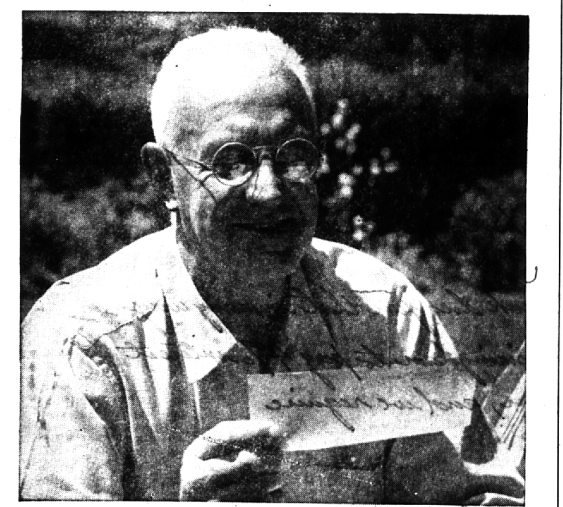
