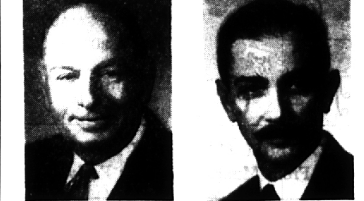
Williams Guest At Dem Dinner
