MEA Employee Switches Jobs

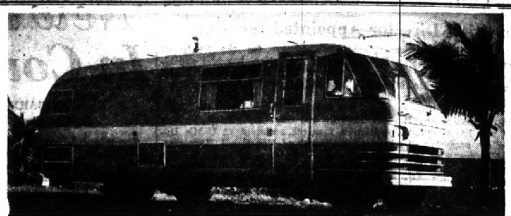
Arthur H. Rice, Jr., former editor of the Michigan Education Association "Journal," has been named MEA assistant executive secretary of information services.

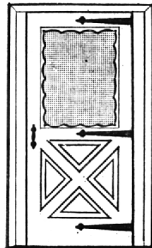

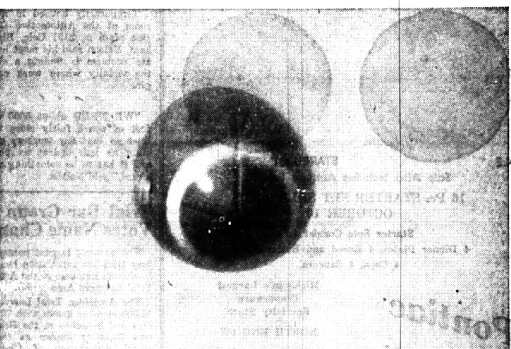

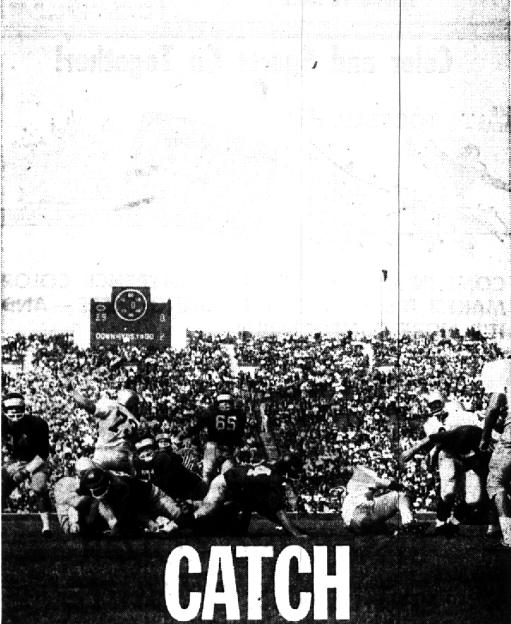
