**Roster Tops At Echo Park In 4th Year**

Echo Park Nursery School and Kindergarten, now in its fourth year, has a near capacity enrollment after starting its 1964-65 season on Sept. 17.

Approximately 140 enrolled students from two and a half to five years of age make Echo Park the largest school of its type in the Detroit area and Michigan.

The school operates in periods of two, three and five days, with classes being held mornings only. Specialized and individual instruction for advanced children are being discussed for use of the school's facilities in the afternoon.

A LOW TEACHER-to-pupil ratio is very important, says Dr. Jack Doussé, the school director and the teachers at Echo Park were selected for their special understanding of the small child.

Reading and arithmetic readiness are part of the school curriculum and the addition of several new buses has increased the efficiency of the school bus service in the area.

Negotiations between state education authorities in Lansing and the school board are being carried out with the intention of eventually adding a first grade to the school.

THE ECHO PARK project was started four years ago by a group of community minded citizens and incorporates an older children's summer camp and riding school.

Area residents serving on the board of directors are: A. O. Braun, Dr. E. J. Westfall, Francis Kotzian, Walter McPhail, David Andrus, Dr. Robert Vedder, David Lawrence and Thomas Bookmeyer. The school and campus at Long Lake and Telegraph roads was formerly a part of the Newcomb estate known as The Junipers.
