### City to Install Water, Sewers For New Homes

The Birmingham city attorney's office was instructed by commissioners Oct. 5 to prepare escrow agreements with two property owners for the installation of sewer and water service.

Both parcels of land are in the W. Maple-Waterfall Lane area of the city.

City Engineer William T. Killeen said that since the sewer and water facilities would be public and maintained by the City he felt the engineering department should have control over the design and construction.

The property owners will pay for the improvements by means of the escrow agreement. They will pay the full cost of the project, including engineering and contingencies.

**KILLEEN SAID** the agreement will also provide that the owner dedicate the necessary easements for the construction and maintenance of the sewer and water.

One of the parcels is owned by Thomas Franke, on the south side of Maple between Woodland Villa Court and Valley View Lane.

Franke, Killeen said, intends to construct five single-family units on the rear of the lot. Because they will be under a single ownership, Killeen said, there is no need to replat the lot.

The other parcel is located at the northeast corner of Waterfall and Maple.

Marshall L. Thomas, owner of the land, plans to construct six single-family units on the property. An easement of access will extend north from Maple to about 170 feet east of Waterfall Lane.

Two units will be built on the west side of the easement and four on the east side.

Birmingham architect Carl Luckenbach is designer for both projects.

"We expect to learn a great deal from these surveys," Zimmerman said. "Today's teenagers are tomorrow's new car buyers. We are doing everything we can to design the kinds of cars now which they will want in a few years. It is for this reason that we are forming this teenage advisory board."
