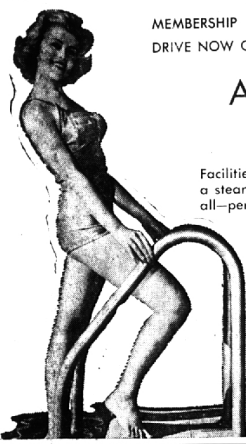

FROM THE BOOKCASE

Goggle Grows to Manhood In a Warmly Told Story

FATHER TO THE MAN by Bentz

If you have cried as you watched your daughter take those slow measured steps down the aisle at her wedding, if you have stood in the chill of an early morning and watched your son fly away to an Army base, if you have locked wills with a young man who has just emerged from the cocoon of his boyhood, you're going to love reading "Father To The Man."

Even if you have never had any of these experiences, you're going to love reading it because of its wisdom, wit and affection.

With warmth and insight, Bentz Plagemann, who authored "This Is Goggle," recounts Goggle's (who now demands to be called Cameron) struggles towards independent adulthood.

LIKE MOST young men Cameron takes the privileges of an urbanity that fizzes the wine of remembrances into a froth of hilarity.

And permeating the whole novel is an aura of love: the love of the mother and father for the boy and he for them, the love of the mother and father for each other and finally the love between the boy and the girl of his choice.

THESE ARE people who care for each other, and because they care, the little things which in the end make up life's most precious satisfactions of the average. It is here that the parent-readers find the "him-too" kinship with Cameron's parents as he seeks them trying to equate what they have expected, with what Cameron wants from life.

FOR PRINCETON turns out to be a nemesis for our hero and the girl from Radcliffe a bore, yet it would be hard to find a more satisfying one. Cameron's road to realization is somewhat different from Holden Caulfield's in Salinger's "Catcher in the Rye," yet it is more recognizable to most of us; this won't be the imperfect dialogue between parents and children. There are just scenes so lifelike and tender that they plunge the reader into the intimacy of identification.

Here is sentimentality with an urbanity that fizzes the wine of remembrances into a froth of hilarity.
