The candy is in the form of candy-filled puppets. The hard candy is individually wrapped and packaged in small puppets resembling scare crows.

The purchase of truck or treat candy helps combat kidney disease through research, education and treatment. It is reported 100,000 people die in this country each year from some form of disease of the kidneys.

IN MICHIGAN the foundation helps support a drug bank program which provides steroid type medication to those afflicted with a kidney disease.

In the new field of kidney transplants the foundation is hoping to bolster limited funds which help to maintain trained professionals and hospitals staffed and equipped to deal with the treatment.
