**B'ham Classroom Average Placed At 25.2 Students**

The average elementary class in the Birmingham School System is 25.2 students, the Board of Education was told Oct. 22.

This was called a "very good condition" by Supt. John Blackhall Smith, who said last year's figure was 25.4.

Average loads of 19 students per class were found in the Walnut Lake first grade, Bloomfield Village second grade and the Meadow Lake second grade. Average highs of 33 pupils per class were noted in the Valley Woods third grade.

Valley Woods also has the highest pupil-per-classroom ratio, 28.1, while Torry has the lowest, 23.1.

"THERE ISN'T MUCH we can do about the 33-student classrooms since there is no more room in those schools," said Smith.

He said some students are now being transferred to other schools to help alleviate the problem, and the school system has also added four new teachers.

In the senior high school level, the board questioned the large number of foreign language dropouts between the seventh and eighth grades. In grade seven French, 743 students were enrolled; in eighth grade French, 377.
