On Sunday, Nov. 8, the guest preacher at the Big Beaver Methodist Church will be the Rev. Maurice E. Glasgow, of Mulliken, Mich. He will preach at both the 9:30 a.m. and 11 a.m. worship services.

He comes to Troy as part of the Michigan Outreach Program of the Methodist Church. There will also be a special Preaching Mission at 7:30 p.m. Sunday, Monday and Tuesday with Mr. Glasgow as the principle preacher.

As another feature of the program the Big Beaver pastor, the Rev. Albert E. Hartong, and the guest minister will conduct a prayer and Bible study session at 10 a.m. on Monday and Tuesday.

MR. GLASGOW is a native of Western Michigan. For the past 11 years, he has served rural Methodist churches in that area. He is a part-time student at Michigan State University and has completed the theological studies of the Methodist Church at Garrett Biblical Institute leading to ordination as a Local Deacon.

The Michigan Outreach program is a vast exchange project in which eastern Michigan Methodist pastors went last weekend to assist the western parishes in a three-day preaching mission. This week the western pastors are reciprocating.

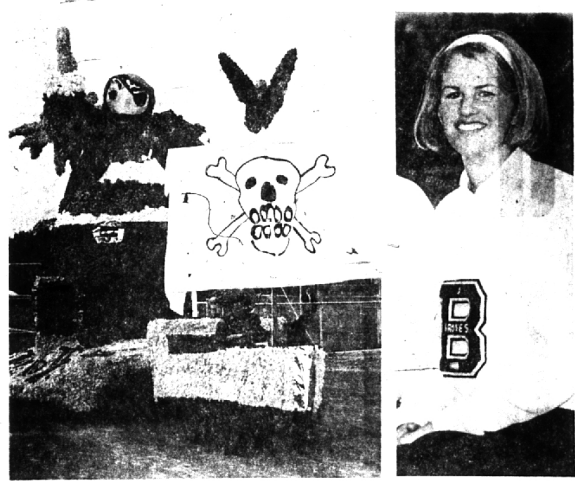
