**EMU Professor Reexamines Election Results**

There was an unexpected but welcome development in the recent presidential election, according to political science professor Edgar Wagh of Eastern Michigan University.

Unwholesome conditions, wherever one-party control had settled over the people, have been exposed to the fresh air of change, he said. In the deep South, he believes, the closed society may be opened to citizens who have found that a two-party system may be useful even if it is to defend prejudice.

SOONER OR later, he said, these same people may discover the greater freedom of two way roads in politics.

In future elections, Prof. Wagh believes there will be little or no mention of some of the issues raised this time as comparing the backlash question with the religious issue in the 1960 election, which he reflects, that once the question had been raised it had been settled.

"Had Kennedy lived," Prof. Wagh believes, "there would have been no mention of religion." So he is with "race" in the future, he declared.
