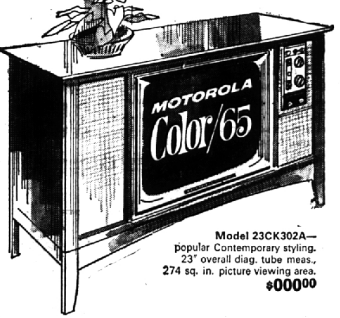

### Capitalism Promoted by Businessman

A challenge to American businessmen to broaden the activities of the free enterprise system for the common good has been issued by Hyron J. Nichols, general manager of Chrysler Corp.'s Dodge Division.

Nichols declared that free enterprise would become a better tool for building a great country if its leaders would become more strongly identified with progressive action and thought in their own communities.

He urged increased participation in government, education and community betterment programs of all types.

"IDENTIFICATION with such essential progressive movements cannot help but bring credit to our business enterprises," he said. "But this identification must represent far more than the way of enlightened individual self-interest."

"It gives broader meaning to the whole concept of free enterprise."

"Our American system of doing business has been gaining ever-increasing acceptance both at home and throughout the world," Nichols said.

"There was a time when we seemed to be somewhat on the defensive whenever we extolled its virtues, but now, happily, that time is past."

"Maintaining this improved identity for business must be one of our foremost concerns."

Nichols said the most important responsibility now facing business is the creation of an ever-increasing number of job opportunities, not just the manufacture of new products and the creation of additional markets.
