

Two Grants Provide for Biology Study

Two research grants in biology to be conducted at Oakland University were accepted recently by the Michigan State University Board of Trustees.

A \$27,000 grant from the Atomic Energy Commission will be used by Clifford V. Harding, professor and chairman of biology, and Walter L. Wilson, professor of biology, continuation of previous research in a study of wound healing. In a continuation of previous research on the subject, they will study the biological mechanism that produces new tissue following an injury.

A grant of \$10,100 from the National Institute of Health will be devoted to research on the electrical charge found in cellular inclusions. Under the direction of professor Wilson, the project will be concerned with measuring this electrical charge and the effects of various physical and chemical agents on it.

Both grants are for one-year periods.

OTHER GIFTS and grants for Oakland University included a grant of \$505 from the Oakland County Engineering Society of Ferndale to establish the Henry Tiedeman Loan Fund for engineering students.

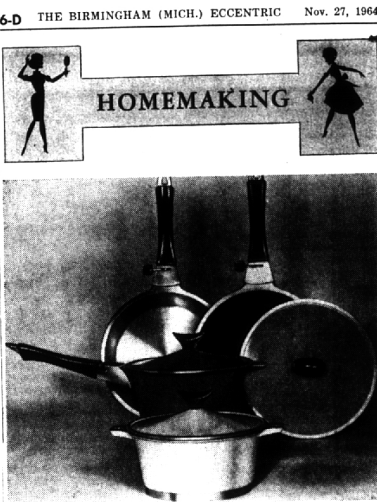

RECIPES FROM B'HAM

Turkey Leftovers Can Be Appetizing

Let's talk turkey—about what to do with those left-overs. Taking a few recipes from cookbooks published by Birmingham organizations, there are several tasty choices.

From 1 1/2 to 3 cups of turkey are used in these interesting entries that will make the day-after-Thanksgiving dinner as appealing in its way as the big feast was yesterday.

TURKEY TETRAZINI (Italian)
2 tablespoons shortening
1/2 cup diced green pepper
1/4 cup mixed onion
1 can cream of mushroom soup
1 cup milk
1/2 lb. sharp cheese, grated
1 teaspoon salt
1/2 teaspoon pepper
1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
1 1/2 cups diced cooked turkey
1/2 8-oz. package spaghetti, cooked
1/2 cup Parmesan cheese
Melt shortening in skillet, saute celery, green pepper and onion until tender but not brown. Blend soup and milk and add to mixture. Add cheese, salt, pepper and Worcestershire sauce, stirring until cheese melts.
Add turkey and heat thoroughly. Combine mixture with cooked spaghetti, sprinkle with Parmesan cheese and serve, or serve tetrazini over the spaghetti. Cooking time is 45 minutes. Serves five.

3 cups flour
1 teaspoon salt

Blend milk, soup and pour over main part of dish (turkey, beans, etc.). Then mix 1 1/2 cup dressing with hot water and melted butter. Place on top.
Bake in hot oven (over 400 degrees) 25 to 30 minutes. Serves eight. Serve warm with another can of mushroom soup for topping.
This may be used as a main dish for a supper or luncheon.
