

Birmingham Woman Appointed to Post

Gifts, Grants Top \$600,000 Mark at WSU

A grant of \$137,600 from the National Science Foundation supporting research in chemistry and mathematics for high school teachers was accepted by the Wayne State University Board of Governors at their month meeting. Total gifts, grants and contracts amounted to \$674,999.

Dr. Calvin L. Stevens, 1414 Lenox, Bloomfield Hills, professor and chairman of chemistry, will direct the institute which begins in Sept., 1965.

The National Institutes of Health, U.S. Public Health Service (USPHS), issued six grants for medical research projects in the School of Medicine and College of Liberal Arts totalling \$82,162.

URBAN All studies at the School of Medicine will be continued by a \$133,957 contract with the USPHS, Bureau of State Services. Dr. Ralph Smith, 24711 Tenth Lane, Birmingham, professor of industrial hygiene, is the project director.

The Kresge Foundation granted \$31,000 to continue the research program in neurological sciences directed by E. S. Gurdjian, M.D., of Detroit, professor and chairman of neurosurgery. Dr. Gurdjian also received \$16,864 for neurological research from the National Institutes of Health.

An endowment fund of \$25,000 will be established for unrestricted scholarship purposes in the name of Louise Tuller Miller from whose estate the money was received.

The board of trustees of Priscilla Inn granted \$15,000 to establish a permanent endowment to be known as the Mary Turner Trust Fund of Priscilla Inn. The income will be used for scholarship purposes in the School of Social Work.

S.L.A. Marshall To Speak on Military History

Brig. Gen. S.L.A. Marshall (U.S.A.-Ret.) 987 Westchester Way, Birmingham, will speak on "Military History: The Myth and the Reality" at 8:15 p.m. Dec. 4, in the Rackham Educational Memorial, Woodward at Warren.

The lecture is one of a series, "Does History Make Sense?," sponsored by the University Center for Adult Education (Wayne State University, The University of Michigan, Eastern Michigan University).

Gen. Marshall, chief historian of the European Theatre of Operations, served as military analyst for The Detroit News until 1963. As syndicated columnist, he also wrote for the Washington Post and the Los Angeles Times. He was a Kresge correspondent in 1953, and a Middle East and Congo correspondent in 1961.

AMONG GEN. MARSHALL'S books are Night Drop, Battle at Best, Illustrated History of W.W. I., and Porkchop Hill, which was later made into a movie of the same title.

Carrier Head Is Hills Man

The influences of the national economic strength, and the national highway system as they affect the trucking industry, were discussed by W. E. Givens, president of the Private Carrier Conference of the American Trucking Associations at the annual convention of Automotive Transport Association of Ontario in November.

HE ALSO outlined growth patterns of both private and for-hire carriers and discussed the effect on both new legislation and government agency regulations.

He said both private and for-hire carriers are growing at approximately the same rate, citing growth statistics from 1939 to the present.

He outlined the role of private carriers in today's highway transportation picture, and discussed the legal actions affecting private carrier operations.

City to Replace 4 Official Cars

Approval was given for the purchase of three new police cars and one administrative vehicle by Birmingham city commissioners Monday night.

DPW Supt. T. C. Brien said that one of the police cars to be replaced was a 1960 Chevrolet used for the radar unit and the other two were 1968 Dodges used for patrol duty. The administrative car was a 1961 Corvair assigned to the manager's office.

"There is accumulated a depreciation of \$6,424 in the equipment pool with a remaining value of \$1,656 on the used cars. Trade-in for the four cars amounted to \$3,050, which makes a book-profit of \$1,394," Brien said.

The four new cars will be purchased from three different auto dealers: one from Harold Turner Ford of Birmingham, two from Town and Country Dodge and one from Spartan Dodge.
