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


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90 Years Young Today

Waterford Man Fatally Injured In B'field Crash

A 29-year-old Waterford Township man was fatally injured early Saturday morning when his station wagon rolled over at the Square Lake Road exit of the I-75 freeway in Bloomfield Township.

Sam P. Cusmano died at 3:20 a.m. from internal injuries at St. Joseph Mercy Hospital, Pontiac. Township police said he was thrown from the car.

Set. Richard Reuther of the traffic safety division said a deep rut in the shoulder contributed to the accident. The vehicle's wheels caught in the rut, he said.

"The car hit the edge of the pavement, slid sideways, rolled over several times and then went over an embankment. Cusmano was westbound at the time of the accident."

school is "basically" the responsibility of parents, particularly in this case when parents made a choice (sending their children to parochial school). Trustee Robert Dolmage felt granting the request would be inconsistent with board efforts to reduce transportation costs.

ACCORDING TO state school officials who drew up procedures to carry out the law, said Troy School Supt. Rex B. Smith, it is illegal for public school buses to carry non-public school pupils beyond school district boundaries.

Those in favor contend it is legal, costs are small, parochial school parents also pay public school taxes, religious teaching is not involved, and public schools will be required to transport many students anyway after parochial schools are built in Troy, Smith said.

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Three B'ham Men Head Purchase of Shopping Center

The purchase of the Farmington Shopping Plaza, involving three Birmingham businessmen was announced today.

The announcement was made by Edward B. Emery, B. H. Carey and Lorne G. Olsen, who head the group making the purchase.

The purchase price was not disclosed. However, it is estimated that the market value of the center is in excess of \$1,400,000.

Speaking of the acquisition, the spokesmen stated that the purchase was made because they are convinced the Farmington area has great "economic potential."

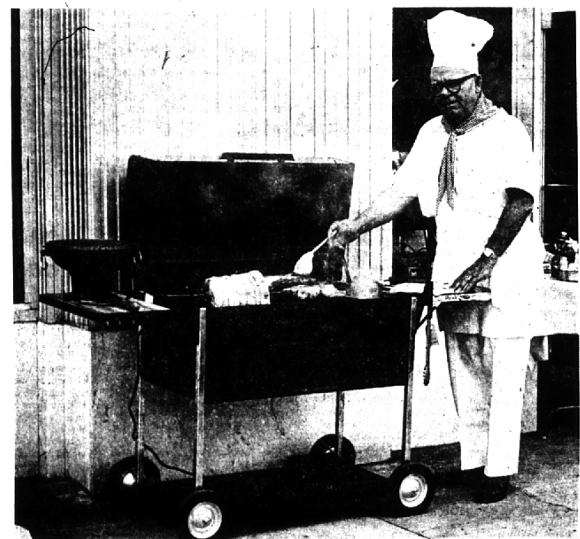
