fore our actions, on the thin, superficialities of living. So many of us have ceased to realize that our easy todays can make difficult tomorrows.

How would you like to have some federal agency send a man to your home and demand that you surrender every gun and/or revolver that you possess? Perhaps you like to hunt birds and wild game and own one or more weapons to use for that purpose. Perhaps, too, you

keep a gun or revolver handy to protect yourself against burglars entering and robbing your home. The right to keep such weapons is an American tradition, dating back to our Pilgrim Fathers. The Institute for Arms Control and Peace held an international symposium at the University of Michigan in December, 1962, on that subject. They proposed that a search be

made of each house by the Army, starting in the west. By 1965 all privately owned firearms would have been seized under this plan, thus making it easier for the United States to be policed by the United Nations "Peace-keeping" International Police Force. (Yes, "eternal vigilance is the price of Liberty.")

His gift to the Boys' Club and Camp Oakland was not a Christmas gift, DeVlieg said.

"The needs of these kids aren't just at Christmas. I think we ought to be wisely generous 365 days of the year."

DeVlieg's new educational assistance program for college students is operated by the Charles E. DeVlieg Foundation. Five scholarships will be awarded each year by a five-man committee of persons outside the DeVlieg organization. Eligible are deserving students with at least a "C" average who live in Ferndale, Oak Park, Berkeley, Royal Oak, Hazel Park, Madison

Heights or Clawson. Children of DeVlieg employees are eligible, regardless of place of residence. DISCUSSING THE award of scholarships to "C" students, DeVlieg said many students got higher grades merely because they absorbed book content with photographic minds. But the "C" student who is intelligent and has the proper attitude and determination, DeVlieg maintains, may make an even greater contribution to his work and his community.

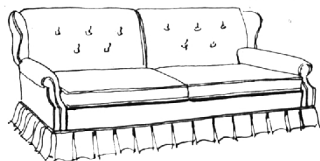

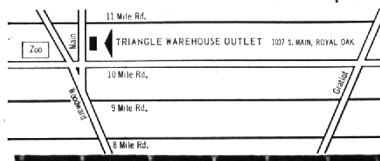

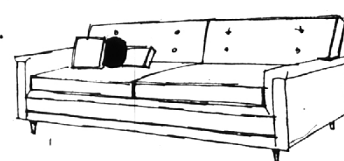
