Grant Will Finance Mathematics School

A National Science Foundation grant of \$30,650 has been awarded to Northern Michigan University to conduct a summer institute for secondary school teachers of mathematics. University officials announced this week. The six-week course will be offered on Northern's campus from June 21 to July 31 next summer with six hours of graduate credit. Open to 30 secondary school mathematics teachers, the course will emphasize geometry from an advanced standpoint. Skill in geometry is necessary in the teaching of mathematics now offered in grades seven through 12.

Dr. Holmes Boynton, professor of mathematics at NMU, will be the director of the institute. Dr. Jerome H. Mannheim, head of Northern's mathematics department, also will instruct the institute.
