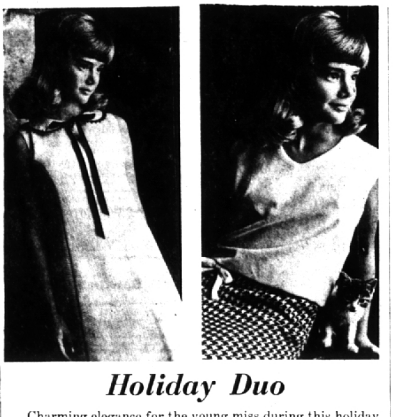

WSU Machine Probes Secrets of Inner Eye

Secrets of the inner eye, once impossible to explore in patients who had thick cataracts, are now being revealed through a product of the electronic age.

The device has a long name, the "electroretinogram," but it makes short work of diagnosis.

Specialists in eye diseases at Wayne State University's School of Medicine have found it so useful that they have recently developed a portable version that may be carried to patients.

"THE OBVIOUS method of examining the eye is to look into it," explains Dr. Albert D. Ruedemann, chairman of Wayne's department of ophthalmology, "but when an obscuring cataract exists, we can't get a good diagnostic look.

"The normal diagnostic tool, called the ophthalmoscope, enables us only to surmise the condition of the retina; so we use the electroretinogram.

"This machine tells us many things we need to know, particularly the information we need prior to eye surgery. Cataract surgery might not be advisable if the machine found a detached or otherwise badly impaired retina," he points out.

THE RETINA is the sensitive layer on the back of the eyeball which captures images which are then transmitted to the brain. When the retinal layer comes loose and flaps within the eyeball, the condition is called retinal detachment. Causes range from an blow on the head to inflammations in the eye or tumors beneath the retina.

Contact lenses are an adjunct of the equipment. These lenses, equipped with electrodes, are fitted to the patient's eyes. Light stimuli passing through these lenses and the eye, activate the visual cells of the retina. These cells transmit varying degrees of electrical response, depending upon the normalcy or abnormality of their function.

These responses are then picked up by the electrodes in the lens and finally recorded on photographic plates.

By this process, the areas of abnormal function may be pinpointed.

"The machine's ability to evaluate disease conditions in the obscured eye has often resulted in the saving of a patient's life," points out Dr. Ruedemann. "It can distinguish a tumor from a cataract and bring about the removal of this malignancy in time."
