Fall Records Announced by State Police

Michigan State Police officers made 19,408 arrests in October, 17,795 for traffic offenses and 1,673 on criminal complaints, according to the department's monthly activity report.

In addition, 559 juvenile traffic offenders were arrested and 598 delinquent minors apprehended. Troopers assisted 4,779 motorists, issued 29,796 oral warnings to drivers, investigated 9,308 cars, and made 15,170 property and 2,804 liquor inspections.

Departmental vehicles traveled 1,809,356 miles, of which 1,072,370 were on traffic patrol and 736,986 to investigate criminal and other complaints.

THE IDENTIFICATION bureau received 13,683 sets of fingerprints, of which 6,984 were criminal and 6,699 noncriminal. Twenty-seven wanted persons were identified.

Of 3,841 applicants for permits to carry concealed weapons, 343 were identified with criminal records through their fingerprints.

Two unknown dead were identified by the same means. The scientific crime laboratory made 413 examinations, of which 242 were on questioned documents, 70 on firearms, 25 on tool markings, 22 microscopic and 54 miscellaneous. Laboratory assistances included 39 to State Police posts or bureaus, 16 to sheriffs, 54 to municipal police and six to state, federal and other agencies.

Seaman Recruit Robert S. Wagner, son of Mr. and Mrs. H. D. Wagner of 620 S. Cranbrook, Birmingham, has reported to training at the Naval Training Center, San Diego, Calif.

He is learning basic military law, customs and etiquette, seamanship, and a basic knowledge of shipboard routine. Also included in the training is extensive military drill, first aid, swimming, water survival tactics, and physical fitness.

Upon completion, a recruit is normally granted leave before reporting to his new duty station or a service school.

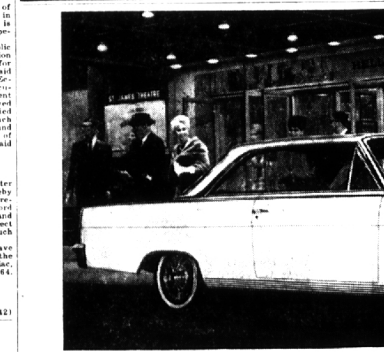

TUNA MOLDED SALAD EASY FRENCH WAY
