Businessmen Are Selective As To Clothes

The colors can be warm and rich without being loud.

The same applies to the socks you may select for him. When he crosses his legs during a business luncheon, he will want shoes with a darkly ribbed length of hose rather than an expanse of hairy calf, so select the high "executive length" sock in black and deep rich gray or brown, or any of those lined with wool, man-made fibers or fur.

DOES YOUR businessman need a warm raincoat? He will like a natural tan, an olive or a black in either the popular split-raglan or the classic full-length style, lined with a warm pile fabric or a plaid or plain wool.

Keep him warm and stylish with neatly figured silk or challis sweaters. Solid color luxurious wools and cashmires fill the bill, too, as do reversibles that flip from solid color wool to nest-fowl patterns.

A great gift keyed to his formal evenings is a black evening waist-coat or cummerbund with a matching bow tie. The waistcoats are newer and will give him a lot of an edge in status.

For other business-like gifts, the gift certificate that is exactly fitted like hats, suits, topcoats, shoes and such, rely on that handy standby, a gift certificate from his favorite men's store.

Prosecutor Condit, Assistants Return To Law Practice

Oakland County Prosecutor Richard P. Condit announced this week that he would return to the private practice of law with the Birmingham law firm of Condit, Denison & Devine upon the expiration of his term of office on Dec. 31, 1964.

Two of his assistant prosecutors, Daniel C. Devine and Charles J. Porter, also tendered their resignations, effective Dec. 31, 1964, and announced that they would join Condit and Birmingham attorney Walter R. Denison in the practice of law.

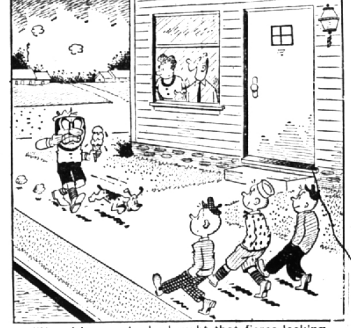
Condit was appointed prosecuting attorney by the County's seven circuit judges in March of this year to fill a nine-month vacancy. A former clerk to Probate Judge Arthur E. Moore and an assistant prosecuting attorney under Prosecutor Frederick C. Ziem, Condit is presently serving as secretary of the Southfield Board of Education.

DANIEL C. Devine, a Beverly Hills resident, was named an assistant prosecuting attorney in 1962 and has tried many major felonies cases, serving in both the Pontiac and Royal Oak offices of the prosecuting attorney.

Formerly Devine was employed in the workmen's compensation department for Chrysler Corp. and also served as Oakland County Probate Court attorney.

Charles J. Porter, of Royal Oak, joined the prosecutor's office as an assistant in 1963 and has been the assistant in charge of the appellate division. Previously he had served as law clerk to Chief Justice Thomas M. Kavanagh of the Michigan Supreme Court.
