**Ford Wins Contract For Armed Forces**

The Ford Division of Ford Motor Co. has been awarded a \$9,895,528 contract by the Army Tank-Automotive Center, Detroit, for 7,171 F-100 pickups to the Army, Navy, Marine Corps and Air Force.

Production of the trucks will start shortly after the first of the year at Ford assembly plants at Wayne, Mich., N. J., Norfolk, Va., Kansas City, Mo.; Dallas, Tex.; Minneapolis, Minn.; and San Jose, Calif. The vehicles are destined for use at military bases throughout the United States and overseas.

This is the fifth contract awarded Ford by A.T.A.C. for commercial-type cars and trucks during the past 30 days. The five contracts have a total value of \$21,201,991 and cover 14,212 vehicles.

**Outdoorsman Is No Problem For Yule Gift**

Gifts for the sportsman or outdoorsman offer no problem at all. He never has enough sweaters. Even if he owns one of each type, he can always use one in another color or another pattern.

Select from big bulky ski-types and fisherman-types, featherweight mohairs and alpaca, muted mixtures in shibbals or softly shaded wools and cashmeres. Choose from all the new patterns, the V-necks, crew-necks, turtle-necks and boat necks.

Look at the cadet collars, the cardigans and pullovers, as well as the zip-up collars that switch from turtle-necks to shirt collars.
