• A new "pot shop" is featured in John Parker Glick's pottery courses, scheduled Tuesdays from 12:30 to 3 p.m. and 7 to 9:30 p.m. The student will be able to use three new wheels, while other new equipment will allow him to start his project with raw materials.

• Approaches in translating ideas into mosaic, stained glass, fused glass, clay, wood and metal will be taught by Betty Com. Thursdays from 9:30 a.m. till noon, and Mondays from 7 till 9:30 p.m.

• Four complete sets of acetylene torches will aid instructor Ken Fadem in his welding classes, scheduled Wednesdays from 9:30 a.m. till noon and Thursdays from 7 till 9:30 p.m. He will teach the fundamentals of cutting, welding and brazing and will offer experiences with steel and cast iron.

The commission to design an Historical Collections Building for the University of Michigan has been awarded to Jickling & Lyman, Architects, 148 Pierce, Birmingham.

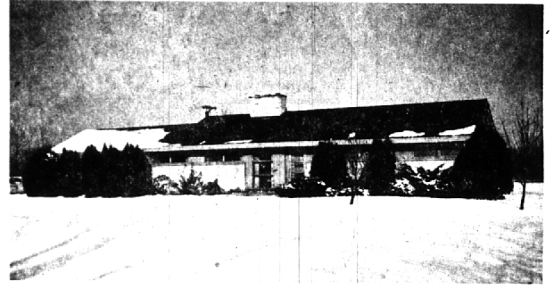
The firm also has been retained to develop a master plan for a new civic and cultural center for the City of Riverview and to prepare plans for a library building and recreation building.

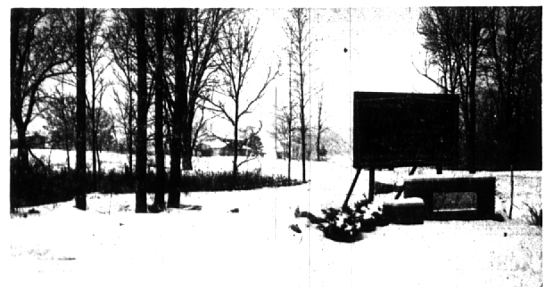
