**Retires From Army**

Lt. Col. George C. Valentine, of 1831 Winthrop, Birmingham, is retiring from the U.S. Army after more than 20 years of service. His retirement is effective Dec. 31. Col. Valentine's last Army assignment was as project officer, Technical Publications Branch, U. S. Army Mobility Command Headquarters, Warren, Mich. Col. Valentine plans to study at Wayne University and retain residence in Birmingham. He plans to enter the teaching field. Prior to coming to the mobility command, Col. Valentine spent 14 months in Korea as an advisor to the first ROK Army. Col. Valentine and his wife, Betty, have three children, John, Susan and Elizabeth.

**Troy Rejects Busing Request Of B'ham School**

A second request in two weeks for parochial school students living in Troy to be picked up by public school buses has been turned down by the Troy Board of Education.  
By an identical vote, 5-2, the board last week rejected the request that bus service be provided for 11 children who attend Our Shepherd Lutheran School in Birmingham.

Two weeks ago a similar request from Guardian Angels Catholic School in Clawson was denied.

**UNDER A** new state law public school buses must pick up students who attend nonpublic schools within the district. Local school boards are left to make the decision on nonpublic schools outside the district.  
The buses could only transport private or parochial students to the district's boundary, according to Troy Supt. of Schools Rex B. Smith.

**Precautions Needed In Hauling Trailer**

It is estimated that the number of travel trailers in use will approach 40,000 by the end of the year, and millions of Americans will be using them for recreation and travel next year.  
Motorists who use trailers should be aware of certain weight restrictions for towing, special equipment needed and state regulations governing trailer use. Chrysler-Plymouth Division engineers provide the following guide:  
The 1965 cars may be used in light trailer towing without special equipment other than a heavy duty turn signal flasher and a heavy duty stop light switch.

**FOR HEAVIER** trailer loads, the company has developed low cost packages of special cooling, electrical, suspension, braking and load bearing components to make trailer towing safer and more pleasurable.  
Although power steering is not required for heavy duty trailer towing, it, too, is recommended.  
Among the other recommendations are an optional high performance engine for safer passing traction on slippery surfaces, external rear view mirrors required by law, spot lights, load lever shock absorbers and emergency flasher system.

**Give WSU Degrees At Commencement**

A total of 1,524 candidates were awarded degrees at Wayne State University's winter commencement exercise Tuesday at Cobo Hall. Dr. Clarence B. Hillberry, president of WSU, will confer 350 bachelors' degrees, 618 masters' degrees, 49 Ph.D. degrees and 16 Ed.D. degrees.

The breakdown by colleges and schools is College of Education, 226 bachelors and 291 masters; College of Liberal Arts, 379 bachelors and 112 masters; School of Business Administration, 104 bachelors and 48 masters; College of Engineering, 29 bachelors and 39 masters; Law School, four bachelors and one master; College of Nursing, 32 bachelors and 24 masters; College of Pharmacy, six bachelors and one master; School of Medicine, four bachelors and 11 masters, and Monteith College, 66 bachelors.
