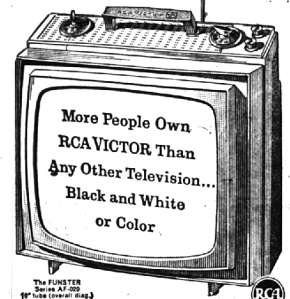
Coffers Filled as Result of Party

Enrollment Up At Wayne State

Wayne State University has advanced to 18th place in grand total enrollment among the nation's uni-versities, moving up from 22nd last year.
In full-time enrollment WSU is 27th compared to 29th in 1963.
These figures are reported by Dr. Garland G. Parker, registrar and admissions officer at the University of Cincinnati, in "School and Society," an education journal.
THE ANNUAL report was based this year on a survey of 1,111 accredited universities and four-year colleges, enrolling 2,090,638 full-time and a grand total of 4,118,735.
Grand total enrollment at Wayne State is 26,200, a gain from 22,310 in 1963. The full-time enrollment is 14,075 compared to 12,154 last year.
Nationally, Dr. Parker found enrollments up 10.1 percent full-time, the greatest gain in recent years. Grand total enrollments increased 9.3 percent.
Nationally, freshman enrollment rose 17.3 per cent. The most substantial gains are in education (18 per cent), the liberal arts and pure sciences (17.3 per cent), business administration (16.8 per cent), nursing (15.9 per cent), agriculture (12.4 per cent) and engineering (11 per cent).
According to the report, 38.5 percent of all full-time students are in the large public universities.

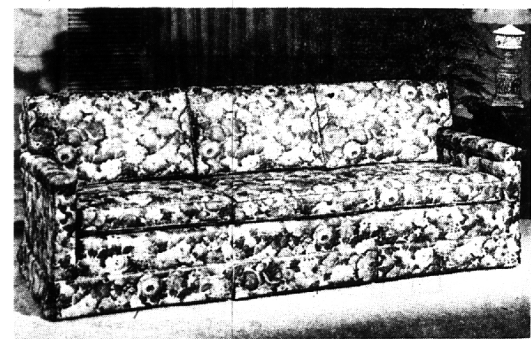

Eclipse of Moon Slated Tomorrow Night, Says Prof.

A total eclipse of the moon will take place tomorrow night, three days before the official beginning of winter, University of Michigan astronomer Hazel M. Losh reminds.
The moon will be in a favorable position for observation, says Professor Losh, because at the beginning of the eclipse it will be about 10 degrees above the eastern horizon.
The moon will first touch the earth's shadow at 8 p.m. Soon after a noticeable dimming at the eastern edge of the moon will show up. The darkened area will gradually spread over the moon's surface until 9:08 p.m., when the moon will be entirely in eclipse.
THE MID ECLIPSE will come at 9:38 p.m., with totality ending at 10:08. It will then take another hour for the moon to leave the shadow completely, Professor Losh says.
During the partial phase, the earth's shadow will appear dark in contrast to the remaining portion of the moon. During the total stage, however, the moon will be illuminated by sunlight, which filters through the earth's atmosphere.
The northern hemisphere will have its shortest day and longest earth's shadow. The moon will then shine with a dull reddish glow, Professor Losh points out. Winter will begin in the northern hemisphere at 2:50 p.m. Monday, the U.M astronomer says. "At this time the sun will arrive at the winter solstice, the most southern point that it reaches during its apparent yearly journey around the earth."
