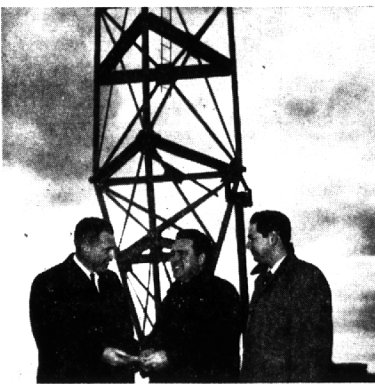

Tobin Rote, a 15-year veteran quarterback in professional football, hung up his cleats for the last time this season.

The one-time Detroit Lion star made his last appearance in a uniform Saturday when he started for the San Diego Chargers of the American Football League in the championship game against the Buffalo Bills.

Rote, who is a resident of Birmingham, directed the Chargers down the field to score the first time they had the ball, tossing a touchdown pass into the end zone to give San Diego a 7-0 lead. Buffalo won the game, 21-7.

**HAMPERED** by a sore arm all year, Rote announced his retirement to return to his business in Detroit. He was honored on Tobin Rote Day in San Diego Dec. 12.

Rote attended Rice Institute, where Jess Neely switched him from fullback to signal-caller. He played for the Green Bay Packers and Lions before going to San Diego.

He was long regarded as one of our football's better passers and ball-handlers.

Roy "Friday" Macklem, the Detroit Lions equipment manager, is serving his 25th season in professional football during the 1964 season.
