

SCHERZO FEATURED

B'ham Musicale Presents All-American Performance

The monthly meeting of the Birmingham Musicale will be held at 1:30 p.m., Feb. 13 at the Community House, Birmingham and will feature the premiere performance of "Scherzo from String Quartet" by Arthur Stephan.

Stephan is the director of the musicale's Instrumental Ensemble, and the entire program is dedicated to the National Federation of Music Clubs' "Parade of American Music."

In addition to the scherzo, the ensemble will play "Go Down Moses," arranged by Morton Gould, "Arioso" by Louis Menotti, "Ballad" by Henry Cowell and "Cottillon Suite" by Douglas Moore.

STEPHAN COMPOSED the scherzo when he arrived in Detroit in 1950. He has been conductor of the Allen Park Symphony Orchestra since 1954 except for the 1955-56 season when he attended the Academy of Music at Vienna, Austria.

Conductor, composer and pianist, he also conducts the International Symphony at Port Huron and Sarnia and directs a 16-voice Cantata Academy Choir.

Sharing the program with Stephan will be soprano Virginia Person. Miss Person first sang for the Musicale just 12 years ago this month.

She has appeared six times with the Detroit Symphony Orchestra and also has appeared with the University of Michigan and the University of Detroit.

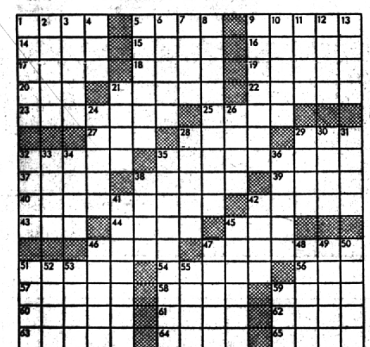
