"Kiddie Kollege" for children age 4 to 11 will be available. It offers children a variety of activities while their mothers participate in their return to campus Conference Day.

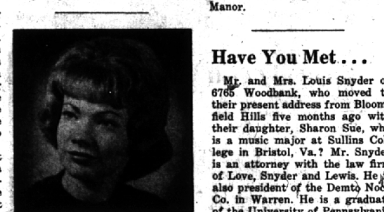

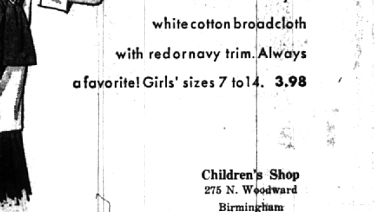
