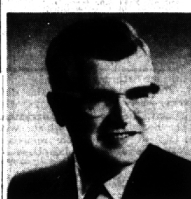
Coy C. Eklund formerly of Birmingham, has been elected senior agency vice president of the Equitable Life Assurance Society. Eklund, a chartered life under-

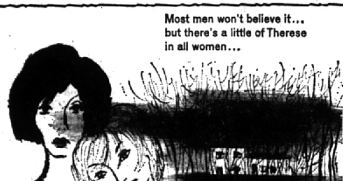
