The outdoors exposition will be open from noon to 11 p.m. Saturdays and Sundays, and weekdays from 1 p.m. to 11 p.m. Over 6,000 free seats are available for the 3 p.m. and 8 p.m. performances of "Parade of Champions" and the 12-act stage show.
