Groves Students Participating in UN Competition

More than 2000 high school students throughout Michigan are awaiting the results of their participation in the 38th annual United Nations Examination given in 82 Michigan high schools under the auspices of the Michigan Division of the American Association for the United Nations, Inc.
 Groves High School is among the seven high schools entered.
 The three-hour examination is designed to stimulate interest in studies of the United Nations and to test the students' knowledge and understanding of the history, structure and major issues before the United Nations and its specialized agencies.
 It is distributed nationally by the United Nations Contest Committee.

FIVE MICHIGAN prizes include a \$50 savings bond and four \$25 bonds as well as entry in the national contest. Winners will be announced at the annual AAUN conference at Kellogg Center, East Lansing, April 18.
 Michigan judges for the contest are headed by Hugh Peters, Fern-dale Public Schools, and include Dr. Melvin Chernov of Oakland University, Fred Haggard of Oakland County APL-CIO, and Ed Ross of Manpower, Inc.

JON CAPREN, adjutant of the Legion, said his group had no choice of dates because the time was established on a state level.
 In addition to being in trouble with the state Legion if another date was picked, Capren said the local post "would be dead" as far as sales go because surrounding communities would sell their poppies to local residents.
