

### State Parley Discusses 'Drop-Outs'

"How to Reduce the Ever-Increasing Number of High School Drop-Outs" was the subject of a two-day conference attended by John Blackhall Smith, superintendent of Birmingham Schools, and Robert A. Bogan Jr., Community House executive director.

The statewide community action conference, held in Flint on April 2 and 3, was cosponsored by the Greater Michigan Foundation and The Mott Foundation Program of the Flint Board of Education.

OVER 400 educators and laymen from every county in Michigan toured the cultural and special education facilities of the Flint school system, and heard Charles Stewart Mott, Founder of the Mott Foundation; Dr. Lynn Bartlett, state superintendent of public instruction; and Gov. George Romney.

Study and work groups formed by the conference delegates unanimously agreed to continue efforts to decrease school drop-outs by increasing efforts to make their local communities aware of the problem and by suggesting some remedies that might be useful.

Delegates also agreed to meet again in the spring of 1965 to evaluate progress, restate objectives and to broaden the area of participation by local community leaders.

The Greater Michigan Foundation suggested that Thursday, May 21, Education Day of the Michigan Week celebration, be used to acquaint the local citizens on the scope and the possible solutions to the school drop-out problem.
