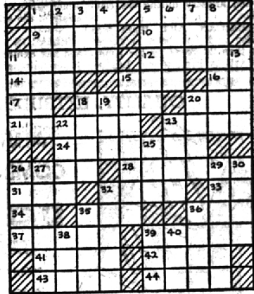

Michigan Artists Slate 54th Annual Exhibition

The 54th Exhibition for Michigan Artists will be held at the Detroit Institute of Arts from July 14 through Aug. 23, according to Robert D. Kingman, associate curator of contemporary art.

It is expected that more than \$4,000 in prizes will be awarded in the exhibition.

All entries will be submitted to jury members Richard Anuszkiewicz, painter from Glen Head, N.Y.; Harold, sculptor from New York City; and Jan van der Marck, curator of the Walker Art Center, Minneapolis, Minn.

In conjunction with the exhibition, Detroit's Richard Koziol will have a one-man show of paintings at the Detroit Institute of Arts.

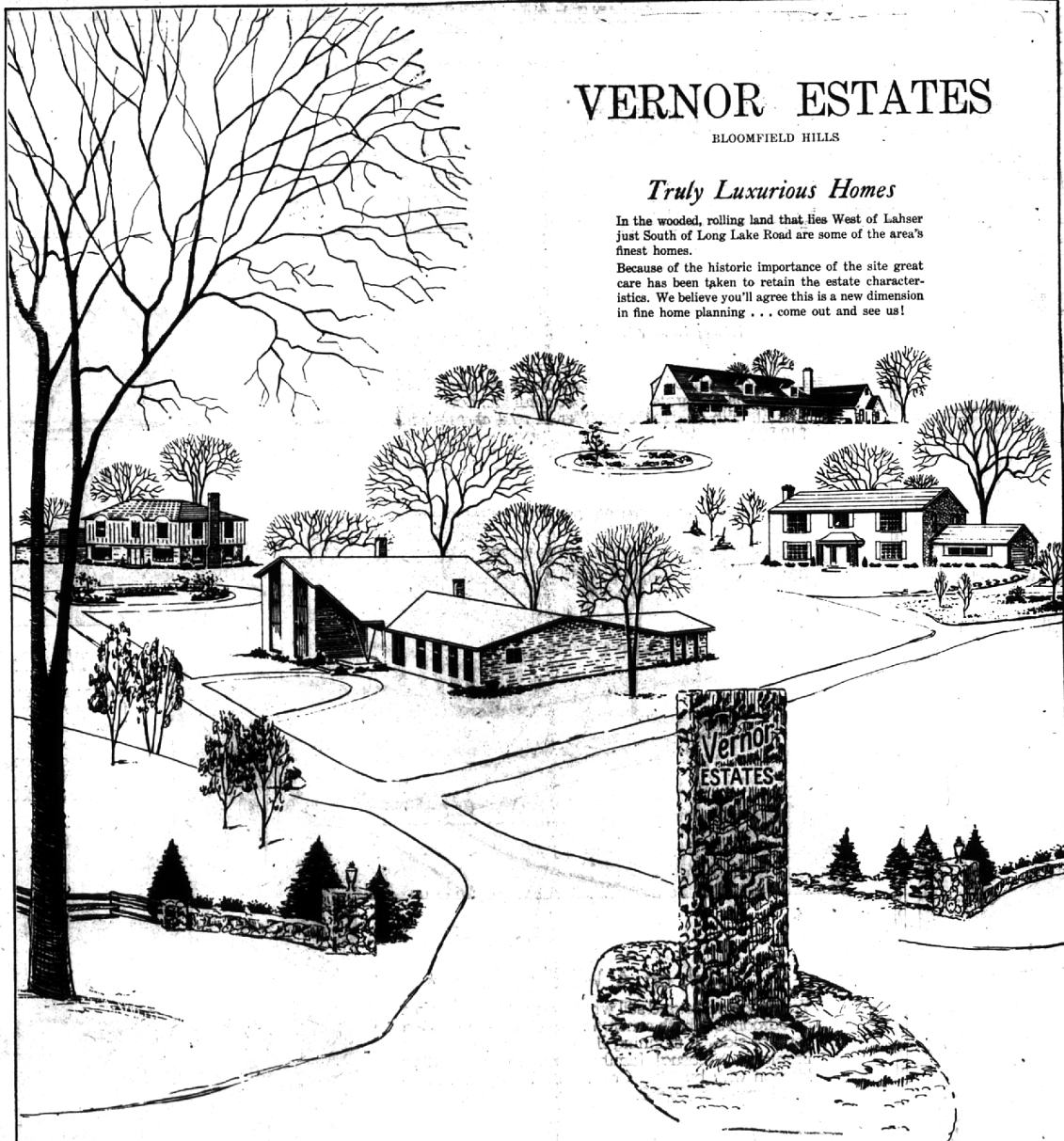
