

### End Expansion In Program for Handicapped

A hold-the-line policy on special education was endorsed by the Board of Education of Oakland Schools Thursday in adopting a budget for next year.

For the first time in the ten-year history of the Oakland County special education program, no expansion is planned.

A budget of \$1,770,031 was adopted, based on revenues from a half-mill special education tax and an anticipated \$77,234 in State Aid.

ACCORDING TO an earlier agreement among superintendents of the districts comprising Oakland Schools, no new special education rooms are to be built, except for filling vacancies; no new teachers are to be hired, only purchases of new equipment will be confined to replacements. No experimental programs are authorized.

The Oakland Schools special education is now serving approximately 24,000 children in programs for the mentally, physically and emotionally handicapped. Kinds of services range from special rooms in which the child's total education is adapted to his handicap to one-time interviews with a visiting teacher or school psychologist.
