

### MSU Graduates Face Bright Job Outlook

Michigan State University graduates in 1964 will have better job opportunities than ever, according to John D. Shingleton, director of MSU's Placement Bureau.

Shingleton based his forecast on fall quarter recruiting activities at MSU, which were at a record pace. He reported that 421 organizations from business, industry, government, and education conducted a total of 2,252 fall term interviews at MSU, 17 per cent more than during fall, 1962. A total of 618 students participated in the interviews.

HE SAID PERSONNEL quotas being established by employers visiting MSU indicate "considerable optimism on the part of business for the coming year."

Shingleton noted that demand for advanced degree candidates is up considerably over that of last year. Master's degree hopefuls at MSU held 60 per cent more interviews last fall than during the same period in 1962.

He said more students are going on to graduate school, and are finding that the extra education means \$76 to \$100 more a month in starting salaries.

Among bachelor's degree winners, science and engineering students are commanding the top salaries, he added. Electrical engineers head the field with an average monthly starting wage of about \$630.

### Pheasants Show Decrease After Season

Southern Michigan's post-season population of pheasants appears to be well below a year ago, according to the Conservation Department.

Some 600 mail carriers reported seeing an average of 1.2 birds per 100 hours of driving while surveying established routes in this part of the state during late November and early December. Their counts after the 1963 hunting season averaged 2.8 birds for every 100 miles covered.

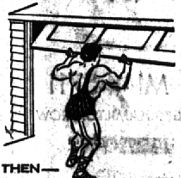
ALTHOUGH PHEASANT numbers are definitely down, particularly in the south-central counties, figures from the two years are not completely comparable, Department game men say.

They point out there was no snow on the ground during the 1963 survey, which made it difficult to spot the birds. Most areas had snow to aid bird counts during the final days of the 1962 survey.

The early-winter pheasant sightings almost match those recorded following the 1961 season when there also was little snow on the ground.
