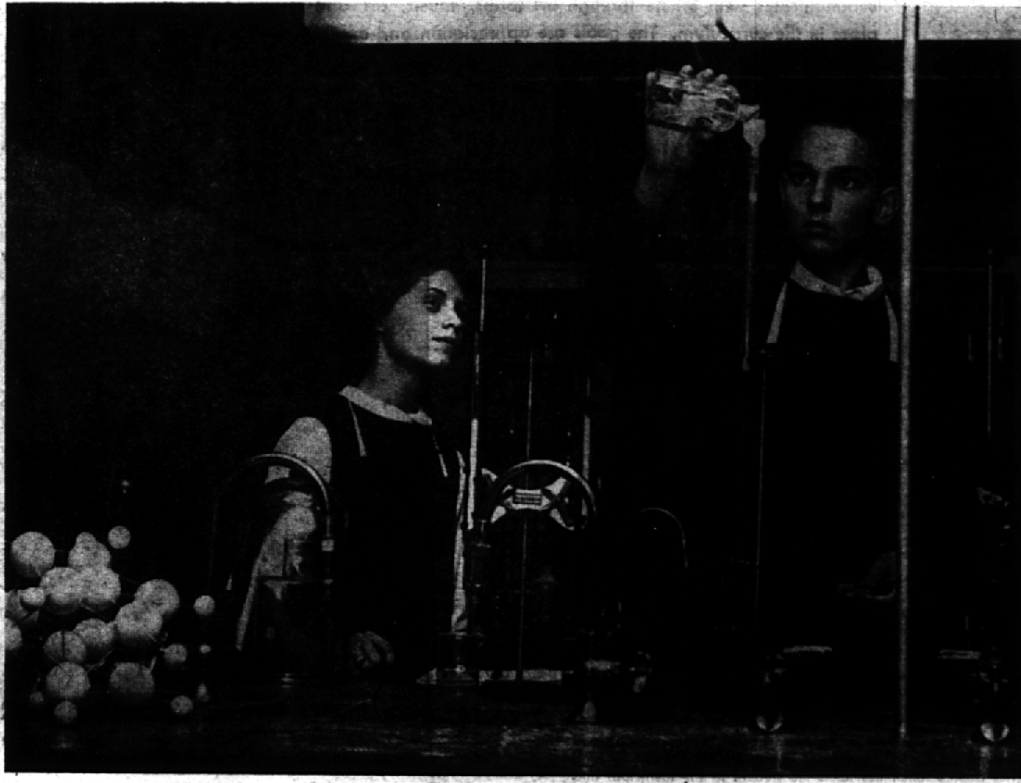


Goal No. 2 . . .
