**GOP Candidate**

William P. Hampton, 2767 Windemere, Birmingham, has announced his candidacy for the Republican nomination for state representative in the third legislative district. He is a partner in the law firm of Hampton and Hampton with his father, Oakland County Court Commissioner, Verne C. Hampton. He received his L.L.B. degree from Wayne State University Law School and was a member of Delta Theta Phi law fraternity. Hampton was an executive assistant to Paul D. Bagwell in his 1960 campaign for governor and worked with Gov. Romney in the 1962 campaign. He is a member of the Junior Chamber of Commerce, Michigan State University Club of Oakland County, Oakland County Bar Association, and the Michigan Bar Association. In announcing his candidacy, Hampton stated: "I am a candidate because I want to represent the people in this district and feel that Lansing needs more young, enthusiastic and energetic representatives."

**Northbrook To Exhibit School Work**

**Women Plan Balkan Dinner**

"A Balkan Festival" will be this year's theme for the annual international dinner of the Oakland County branch of the Women's International League for Peace and Freedom.

The dinner, to which the public is invited, will begin at 7 p.m. Saturday, at the First Federal Savings and Loan Association, 762 West Huron, Pontiac.

A WHITE elephant auction is also planned, and proceeds will be used to purchase transistor radios for the Gularat area of India.
