

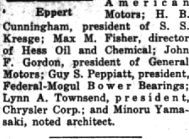

 At the same time, Hogan, a Birmingham attorney, publisher, and state legislator, announced also that the Walled Lake Public Library Board has been awarded the Oakland County Achievement Award for outstanding service to the citizens in that community.
 Recipient of the 1964 Oakland County Agricultural Award, a new Michigan Week highlight, Hogan said, is the Travis Turkey Farm in Oxford. "This organization," is regarded by poultry authorities everywhere as a model of its kind.
