### Aboard USS Midway

Jeffrey W. Ruppert, seaman apprentice, USN, son of Mrs. Wanda E. Ruppert of 6983 Lahser Road, Birmingham, is serving aboard the heavy cruiser USS Saint Paul which participated in "Red Cloud", a major fleet exercise conducted off the coast of Southern California March 25 to April 3.

The exercise was designed to train and test Pacific Fleet units in strike, anti-aircraft and anti-submarine warfare.
